

## CANINE WELLNESS BASICS

Puppy 6-10 week - 16+ weeks	Adult 1 year – 7 years	Senior 8+ years
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Distemper, parvovirus, Adenovirus 1 &amp; 2, Parainfluenza (CORE) every 3-4 weeks up to 16 weeks or older</li> <li>– Rabies (CORE) preferred older than 14 weeks</li> <li>– Bordetella (Non CORE) greater than 8 weeks, 2 doses 3-4 weeks apart</li> <li>– Leptospirosis -4 way (Non CORE) greater than 14 weeks, 2 doses 3-4 weeks apart</li> <li>– Influenza (Non CORE) 2 doses, 3 weeks apart for high risk pets</li> <li>– Heartworm and Flea/Tick prevention started year round</li> <li>– 2 Rounds of deworming for GI parasites</li> </ul> <p><b><i>*Note: age categories and needs may change based on size and breed</i></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– DH2PP/Rabies year after completion of puppy vaccinations then every 3 years</li> <li>– Bordetella every 6 months to yearly based on lifestyle</li> <li>– Leptospirosis yearly based on lifestyle</li> <li>– Influenza yearly for high risk pets after initial 2 doses</li> <li>– Yearly wellness panel, heartworm and tick-transmitted pathogens testing</li> <li>– Intestinal parasite analysis every 6 months – yearly based on lifestyle</li> <li>– Year round Heartworm, Flea/Tick prevention</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Rabies every 3 years</li> <li>– DH2PP every 3 years or based on potential exposure and health status</li> <li>– Leptospirosis yearly based on lifestyle</li> <li>– Influenza yearly for high risk pets after initial 2 doses</li> <li>– Total Health blood work including thyroid screening every 6 month to yearly</li> <li>– Urinalysis and urine:protein testing yearly</li> <li>– Pre-anesthetic ECG screenings</li> <li>– Blood pressure yearly screenings</li> <li>– Chest and abdominal health screening X-rays</li> <li>– Yearly Heartworm and tick-transmitted pathogens testing</li> <li>– Intestinal parasite analysis every 6 months – yearly based on lifestyle</li> <li>– Year round Heartworm, Flea/Tick prevention</li> </ul>

## FELINE WELLNESS BASICS

Kitten 6-10 weeks – 16+ weeks	Adult 1 year – 7 years	Senior 8+ years
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– FIV/FelV viral testing prior to vaccines</li> <li>– FVRCP: Feline viral Rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, and panleukopenia (CORE) every 3-4weeks up to 16 weeks or older</li> <li>– Rabies (CORE) preferred older than 14 weeks</li> <li>– FeLV (Non CORE) AAFP recommendation 2 doses, 3-4 weeks apart after 8 weeks</li> <li>– Heartworm and Flea/Tick prevention started year round</li> <li>– 2 Rounds of deworming for GI parasites</li> </ul> <p><b><i>*Note: age categories and needs may change based on size and breed</i></b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– FVRCP year after completion of kitten vaccinations then every 3 years</li> <li>– Rabies year after completion of kitten vaccinations then every 1-3 years based on the product labeling</li> <li>– FeLV year after completion of kitten vaccinations then every 2-3 years based on risk and lifestyle</li> <li>– Yearly wellness panel and heartworm testing</li> <li>– Intestinal parasite analysis yearly</li> <li>– Year round Heartworm, Flea/Tick prevention</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>– Rabies every 1-3 years based on the product labeling</li> <li>– FVRCP every 3 years or based on potential exposure and health status</li> <li>– FeLV every 2-3 years based on risk and lifestyle</li> <li>– Total Health blood work including thyroid screening every 6 months to yearly</li> <li>– Urinalysis and urine:protein testing yearly</li> <li>– Pre-anesthetic ECG screenings</li> <li>– Blood pressure screenings every 6 months to yearly</li> <li>– Chest and abdominal health screening X-rays yearly</li> <li>– Heartworm testing yearly</li> <li>– Intestinal parasite analysis yearly</li> <li>– Year round Heartworm, Flea/Tick prevention</li> </ul>
